

Type of Mediator:

Court-Employed or Private

How do cases get to mediation?

Probate: Private

Juvenile: Court order in custody and visitation cases

How do parties request mediation?

Probate: Contact a private mediator

Juvenile: Parties can request during pre-trial or seek private mediation

Is there a cost, not included in the filing fee, to the parties for mediation?

Not if the mediation is done by the court-employed mediator.

Is pre-filing mediation available?

No

Mediated Case Types:

Probate: Any appropriate case may be referred to private mediation at the cost of the parties. See Probate Local Rule 36.
