




6. Filings will be accepted via FAX at 440-328-2157 or email at [lcprobate@loraincounty.us](mailto:lcprobate@loraincounty.us). This does not apply to original case filings.
7. Where personal service of the Notice of Appointment of the filing of a guardianship required by R.C. 2111.04 is not possible, the Court will appoint the Guardian on limited basis pursuant to R.C. 2111.02(B)(1). The Court will conduct a full guardianship hearing in the future at the earliest possible date when the required personal service is completed.
8. Forms for most probate cases are available at: <http://www.loraincounty.com/probate/forms/>. Parties are encouraged to use these forms and return the forms to the Court via mail, private delivery, email or fax. Parties are further encouraged to delay filings that are do not constitute an emergency or are not required by Ohio law.
9. The Court will be flexible with all filing deadlines imposed by the Local Rules on June 6, 2019.

It is the intention of the Court to remain in operation to perform its essential functions. The General Orders herein are meant to discourage anyone from personally appearing in the offices of the Lorain County Probate Court unless absolutely necessary.
