

- (5) Walk-in Arraignments for all OVI cases or cases in which there is an alleged victim, including, but not limited to, Domestic Violence, Assault, Criminal Damaging, Child Endangering or a crime of a sexual nature. These hearings require prompt attention by a Judge because they are time-sensitive and need to be addressed promptly.
- (6) Any other matters the Judge deems time-sensitive and for which the need for prompt addressing outweighs the damage/damages inflicted by postponing such events.

(B) CASES BEING CONTINUED IN WHICH DEFENDANTS NEED NOT
APPEAR

Unless otherwise notified by the Court, appearances for those cases listed below shall be continued. Those cases are as follows:

- (1) Traffic arraignments
- (2) Non-violent Misdemeanors
- (3) Scheduled Case Management Conferences, Pre-Trials, Motion Hearings, Status, Final Pre-Trials and Pleas.
- (4) Trials (Bench and Jury)
- (5) The Defensive Driving Program scheduled for April 13 and 20, 2020, will be rescheduled to sometime in June.
- (6) All Civil hearings currently scheduled including Motion Hearings and Small Claims matters.
- (7) Eviction cases will be scheduled as follows: Evictions and putouts for non-payment of rent will be continued and reset beginning in mid-June, 2020. Evictions and putouts for domestic violence, assault, drug use or drug dealing will proceed as quickly as possible. Eviction filings will continue to be taken at the Clerk's window.


MISCELLANEOUS

The Court is in the process of installing a video conferencing and remote access program. Once that is in place and operational, face-to-face Pre-Trials can be held between Defendant's Attorney, the Prosecutor and the Court. The hope is to have the system fully in place by next week. More information will be forthcoming.

Once the video conferencing is operational, we will resume scheduling Pre-Trials, etc., requiring appearances of Attorneys, Prosecutors and the Court. Defendants will generally not be required to appear unless specifically ordered by the Court.

Attorneys should contact the respective Judge or Magistrate office to continue and reschedule cases.
