99-924. York v. Mayfield Neurological Inst., Inc.

Butler App. Nos. CA96-08-164 and CA97-03-057. This cause is pending before the court as an appeal and cross-appeal from the Court of Appeals for Butler County. On December 21, 1999, the court ordered that the name of Gary L. Gardner be stricken from appellants/cross-appellees' merit brief and that Gary L. Gardner not be permitted to appear in this case because he is not admitted to practice in Ohio and had not complied with the *pro hac vice* requirements of S.Ct.Prac.R. I(1) and (2). On January 28, 2000, counsel for appellants/cross-appellees filed a motion requesting that Gary L. Gardner be permitted to appear *pro hac vice* and participate in oral argument of this case. Whereas this court has ordered that Gary L. Gardner shall not be permitted to appear in this case, and whereas counsel's request is untimely pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. I(2)(B),

IT IS ORDERED by the court, *sua sponte*, that the motion to permit Gary L. Gardner to participate in oral argument be, and hereby is, stricken.
