## MOTION AND PROCEDURAL RULINGS

### **2013-1088. Lincoln Elec. Co. v. Travelers Cas. & Sur. Co.**

Certified Question of State Law, United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division, No. 1:11CV2253. This cause is pending before the court as a certified question of state law from the United States District Court, Northern District of Ohio, Eastern Division.

Upon consideration of the motions for admission pro hac vice of Elliot Schulder, Timothy D. Greszler, Anna Phipps Engh, and William Passannante, it is ordered by the court that the motions are granted. Pursuant to Gov.Bar R. XII(4), counsel shall file notices of permission to appear pro hac vice with the Supreme Court's Office of Attorney Services within 30 days of the date of this entry.

### **2013-1234. Elmwood Place v. Ruhlman.**

In Mandamus and Prohibition. This cause originated in this court on the filing of a complaint for a writ of mandamus and prohibition.

Upon consideration of relator's memorandum in support of the issuance of an emergency alternative writ of prohibition, it is ordered that the request for emergency relief is denied at this time. Pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 7.01(A)(3), the relator has an adequate remedy at law in the companion jurisdictional appeal. The merits of this case will be considered in the ordinary course pursuant to S.Ct.Prac.R. 12.04.
