JUDGEMENT ENTRY

This matter came before the Court for hearing on July 6, 1998, upon the Petition of the State of Ohio, Bureau of Motor Vehicles, (hereinafter "BMV") for a judicial declaration that Appellant Morris May is a "vexations litigator" within the meaning of R.C. 2323.52., filed June 1, 1998. Assistant Attorney General Stephen H. Johnson appeared on behalf of BMV. On June 4, 1998, Morris May filed a written Reply but did not appear at the hearing.

The Court has considered the matters raised in the BMV's Petition and in the Reply thereto, and takes judicial notice of the various pleadings, motions and decisions of this Court and of the Court of Appeals, as reflected on the Court's docket in Case No. A9110966.

This Court finds Appellant to be a "vexatious litigator" as defined in R.C. 2323.52. Therefore, it is ordered, decreed and adjudged that Appellant Morris May is permanently prohibited from engaging in any of the following conduct without first obtaining leave of the court:

(a) Instituting legal proceedings in the court of common pleas, municipal court or county court;

(b) Continuing any legal proceedings that Morris May has instituted in the court of claims or in the court of common pleas, municipal court or county court prior to the effective date of this Order, or,

(c) Making any application, other than an application for leave to proceed under division (F) of Section 2323.52 of the Ohio Revised Code, in any legal proceedings instituted by Morris May or another person in the court of claims or in the court of common pleas, municipal court or county court.


Failure of Appellant Morris May to comply with any of the conditions set forth in (a) through (c) of this Order, shall result in dismissal of the filing by the vexatious litigator.

The Clerk of Courts is directed to send a certified copy of this Judgment Entry to the Ohio Supreme Court for publication in accordance with R.C. 2323.52(H).
